- Work with the Deputy Headteacher to implement strategies and monitoring systems for the management of consistent behaviour to enable the highest possible standards of learning for every student.
- Build on home school liaison through parent support and engagement.

Banovallum is a mixed 11-16 over-subscribed secondary school at the heart of the local community. *Relationships between staff and pupils are very positive. Pupils trust their teachers to help them do the best they can. (Ofsted December 2017)*
